Funds raised by ETF in Australia enable the construction of preschools in remote areas of Timor-Leste, our second closest neighbour.

We are looking for a volunteer that is committed to making a positive difference, working with others on various tasks in order to achieve Educating The Future's goal of providing construction and/or renovation of preschool infrastructure to Timor-Leste. Educating The Future is a not-for-profit run by young people and we expect that you can work well with others in a fast-paced, dynamic, digital and innovative environment.

A lot of the work conducted by the Business Development team will be self-driven and taking initiative is key to a successful contribution. ETF does not require that applicants have specific skills or qualifications to join our team, including undertaking a university degree. We expect that at a minimum, you have an interest in this field and are willing to learn. However, you will be positioned to make an immediate impact in this team if you are from the following background:

- Commerce studies including finance, management, accounting and information systems students
- Engineering, law and medicine students
- Arts and social science students
- Any consulting experience (e.g. societies such as 180 Degrees Consulting, Enactus and Business One) will be looked on favourably

Position summary:

The Business Development team is responsible for supporting Educating The Future's strategic initiatives and overall direction. The Business Development team will support the capabilities of the other teams, and be involved in a range of long and short-term initiatives.

Other selection criteria:

- Willingness to learn and commit to the organisation

- Alignment with ETF's organisation values of youth-led, collaborative, forward thinking and accountable
- Ability to commit 4 hours per week including attending team meetings every two weeks
- Ability to communicate and work independently, and virtually
